NOTES

File No. with a decimal (851.5) is the number given by the County Recorder.

File No. with a letter (851A) created by the transcriber, usually multiple persons in the same file.

There are a few cases where they (A and B) are separate files.

Struck by train or struck by train no. xx refers to the Southern Pacific Railroad.

Name spelling is from the actual records.

"•" in Cause of Death indicates a copy of the State Death Record is included in the file.

"?" after a city indicates that the city is not in atlases of 1895 and 1960 for that state.

(a.r.) Indicates death date is the date of the Autopsy Report.

r. represents victim's city of residence beginning with Box 24 due to a new department form.

Barbiturate/Drug Content = (xx ppm)
